# Water pipe work in the Farndon area

We want to make sure we all have plenty of wonderful water – today, tomorrow and in the years to come and we're investing £1.2million to make sure everyone in Farndon and Holt receives a reliable and sustainable water supply. That's why we're installing a brand-new water pipe starting on the Holt side of the riverbank, ending at the junction of Church Street. Please see map below. Once phase 1 of the work is complete the overland pipe which is currently running along Farndon Bridge, will be removed.



### Information you need to know

This work will start on Monday 8 July 2024 and is due to be completed by end of December 2024. Please be aware that although we try to stick to these dates, they may change due to circumstances beyond our control.

Please see table below which explains what traffic management is to be used. To carry out some of the work safely we've agreed with the local authority to close some roads to through traffic. We know the impact road closures have on communities and only do it when it's absolutely necessary for the safety of residents and our team. Access to homes, businesses and emergency vehicles will be maintained. There may be occasions when vehicle access to your property is restricted for short periods of time; for example, if we're working on the road directly outside your property. We'll let you know in advance if this is going to be the case — please let us know if you have any specific requirements or needs.

## Will my water supply be affected?

If we plan to interrupt your water supply, we'll notify you in advance with a card stating the date and the earliest start and latest end time of the interruption. The card is normally hand delivered **48 hours** before the planned interruption.

You may want to store some extra water in jugs or containers during this period so you can continue to wash your hands and flush the toilet. It's advisable to avoid using any appliances connected to the water supply during this period.
